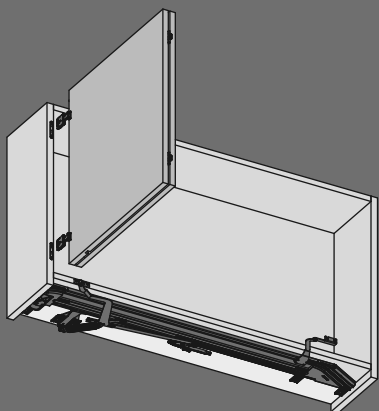

Left-hand 180° opening door - Assembly instructions

Warning

For professional use only.

Read the assembly instructions carefully before installation, and give this safety data sheet to the end user of the cabinet.

Ensure that the load-bearing capacity of the cabinet is suitable for the type of hardware to be installed.
The cabinet must have a sufficiently rigid and stable structure to prevent collapse or breakage during assembly and use.

Wear suitable personal protective equipment during assembly operations.

Do not attempt to work on the mechanism without prior training.

Warning: spring-action mechanism may produce sudden, uncontrolled movement.

If you have any doubts or needs during installation, please contact technical assistance.

System for concertina doors

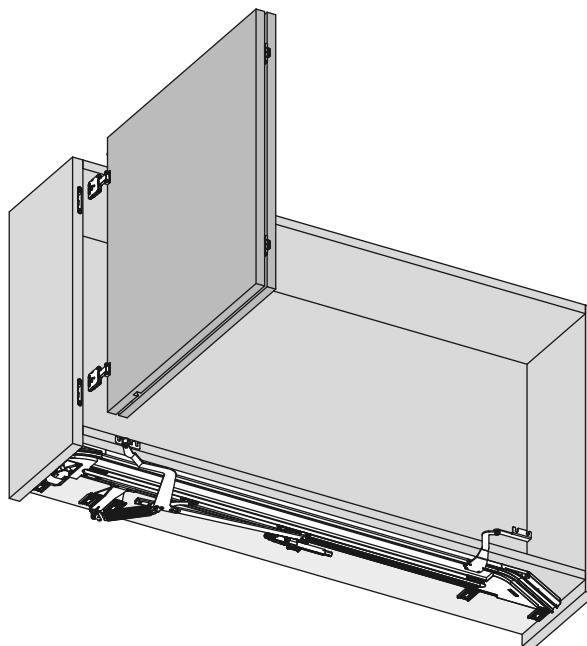
- Maximum opening 180° adjustable up to 170°
- Automatic opening and closing action controlled by silicon oil dampers and by a magnetic damper for a smooth and gently decelerated movement
- Fixing of the doors to the cabinet side with external SERIES M hinges or with recessed CONECTA hinges

BASE version

- The track can be assembled under the bottom panel of the cabinet for column units, wardrobes and base units
- Adjustment of door opening and closing speed
- Doors fully adjustable in three directions

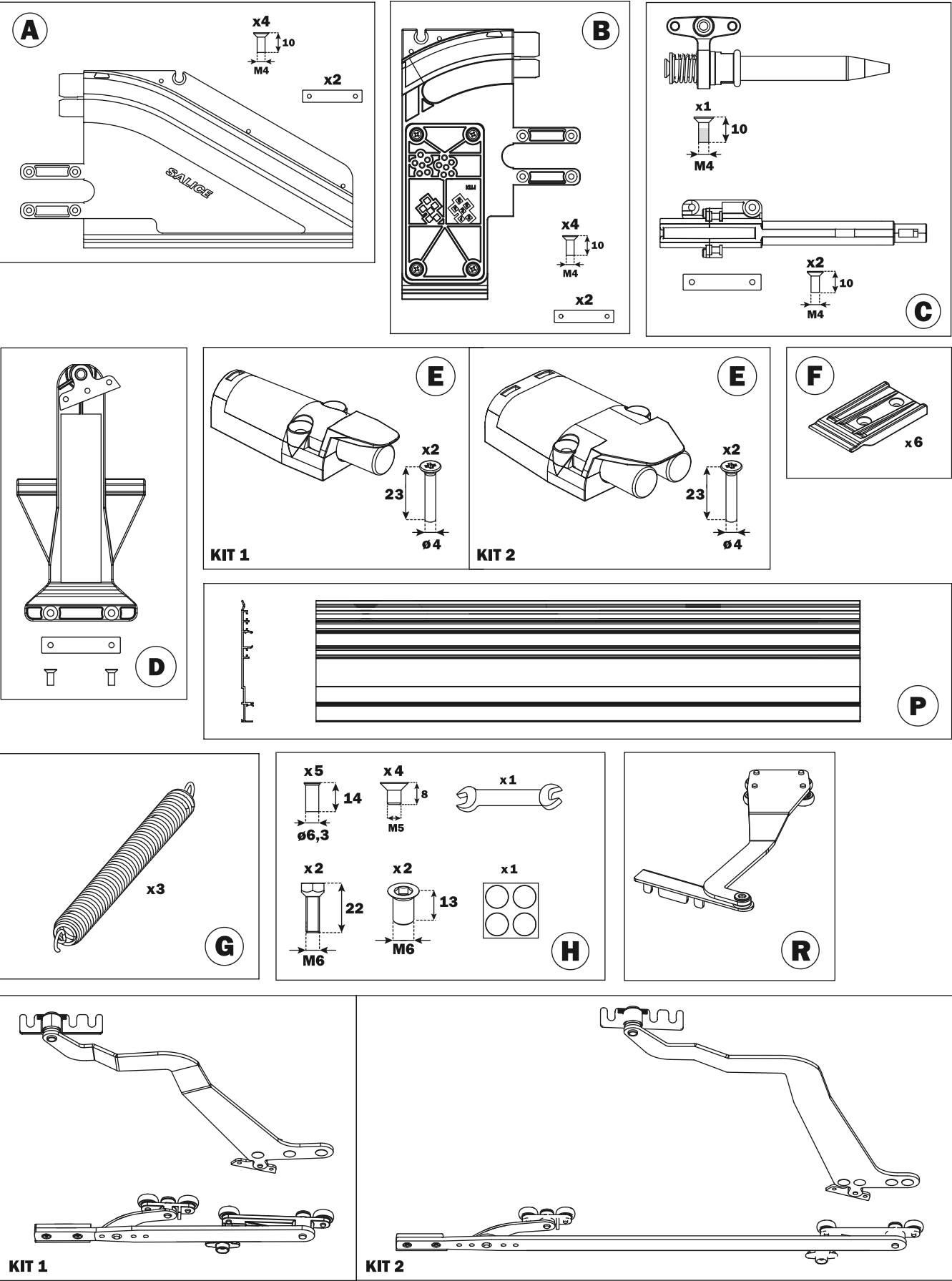
- Thickness of wooden door with SERIES M hinges:
from 18 mm to 24 mm
- Thickness of wooden door with CONECTA hinges:
from 18 mm to 25 mm
- Thickness of wooden door with profile VE79KITE710_A with CONECTA hinges:
from 22 mm to 25 mm
- Width of each single wooden door:
from 350 mm to 750 mm
- Width of each single aluminium-framed door:
from 350 mm to 600 mm
- Door height:
 - Minimum 600 mm
 - Maximum 2800 mm
- Formula for minimum door height
 $HA \text{ Min.} = (4 \times TL) / 3$
Example:
TL = 600
HA Min. = 800
- Cabinet depth ≥ 320 mm
- Side thickness with recessed CONECTA hinges ≥ 19 mm

TL = Door width

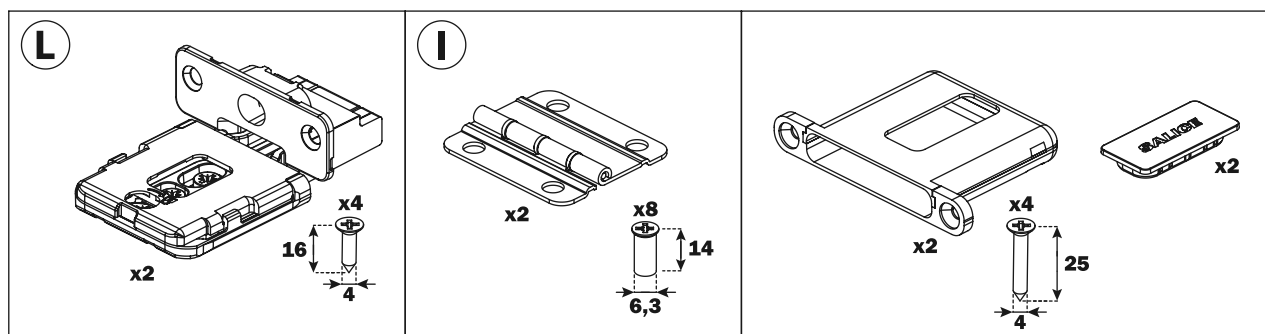

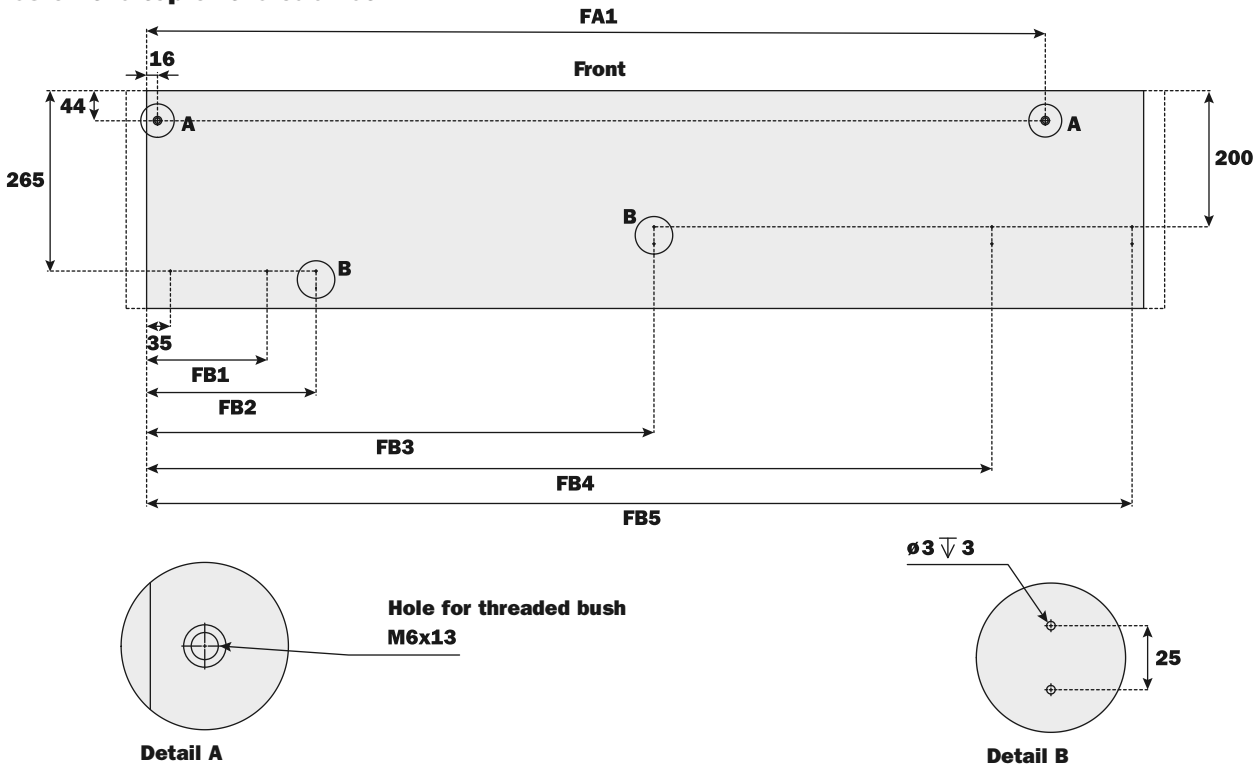
Formula to determine the length of the profile to be cut

$LP = (2 \times TL) + X - D1 - 338.5 \text{ mm}$



- LP = Profile length
- TL = Door width
- X = Reveal between doors
- D1 = External door overlay on side
- D2 = Internal door overlay on side

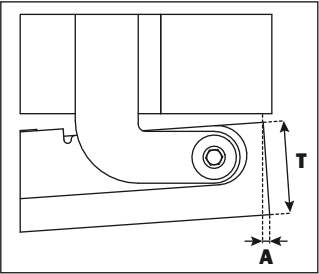

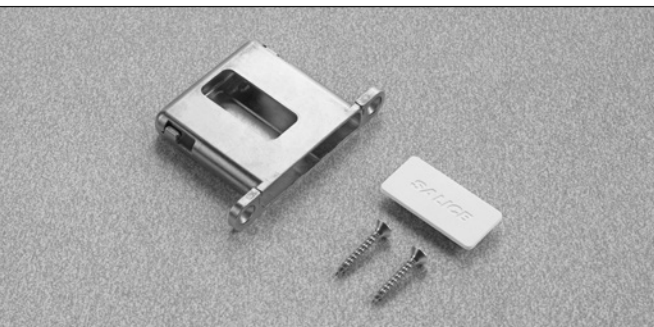
To be screw-fixed on the cabinet side:

- For single door with Euro screws, drilling $\varnothing 5 \times 16$ mm
- For double doors with $\varnothing 5$ mm interscrews
- Fixing screws and cover caps included in the single packing
- Fixing screws included in the industrial packing

- Door overlay on side hinged side D1 = 10 mm

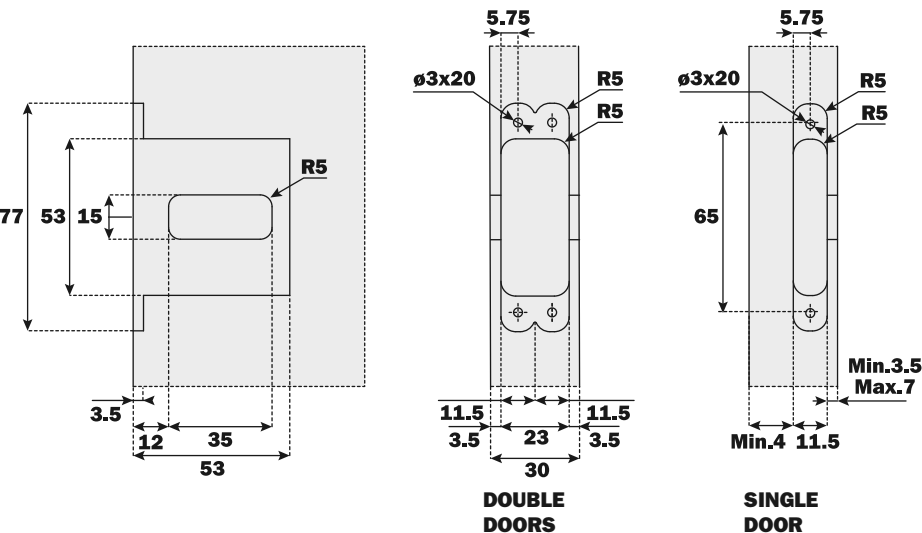

- For single door and double doors with $\varnothing 4 \times 25$ mm screws
- Fixing screws and cover caps included in the single packing

Glass sizing

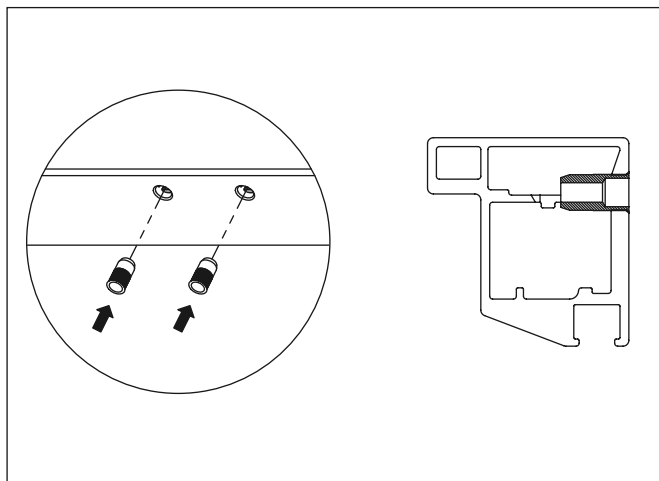
V1 = Glass width

Tightening of threaded bushes for M4 metric screws before fixing the hinges

Insertion of threaded bushes

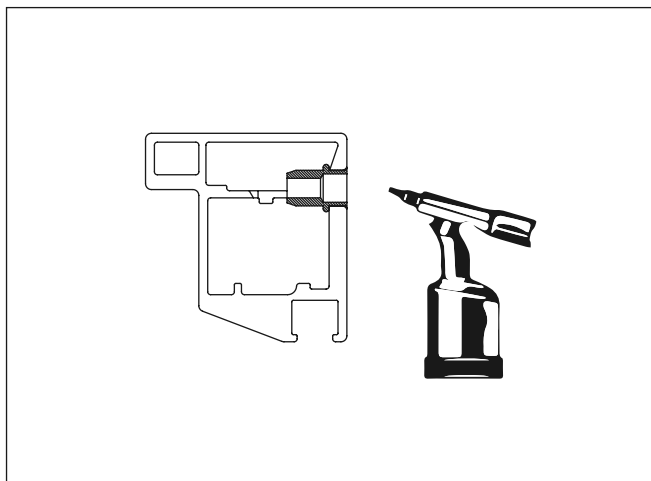
Insert the threaded bushes in the appropriate place



Fasten the threaded bushes to the frame using a riveting tool.

Check the tightness of the threaded bushes before fixing the hinges to the frame.

Remove and replace any threaded bushes not properly secured.

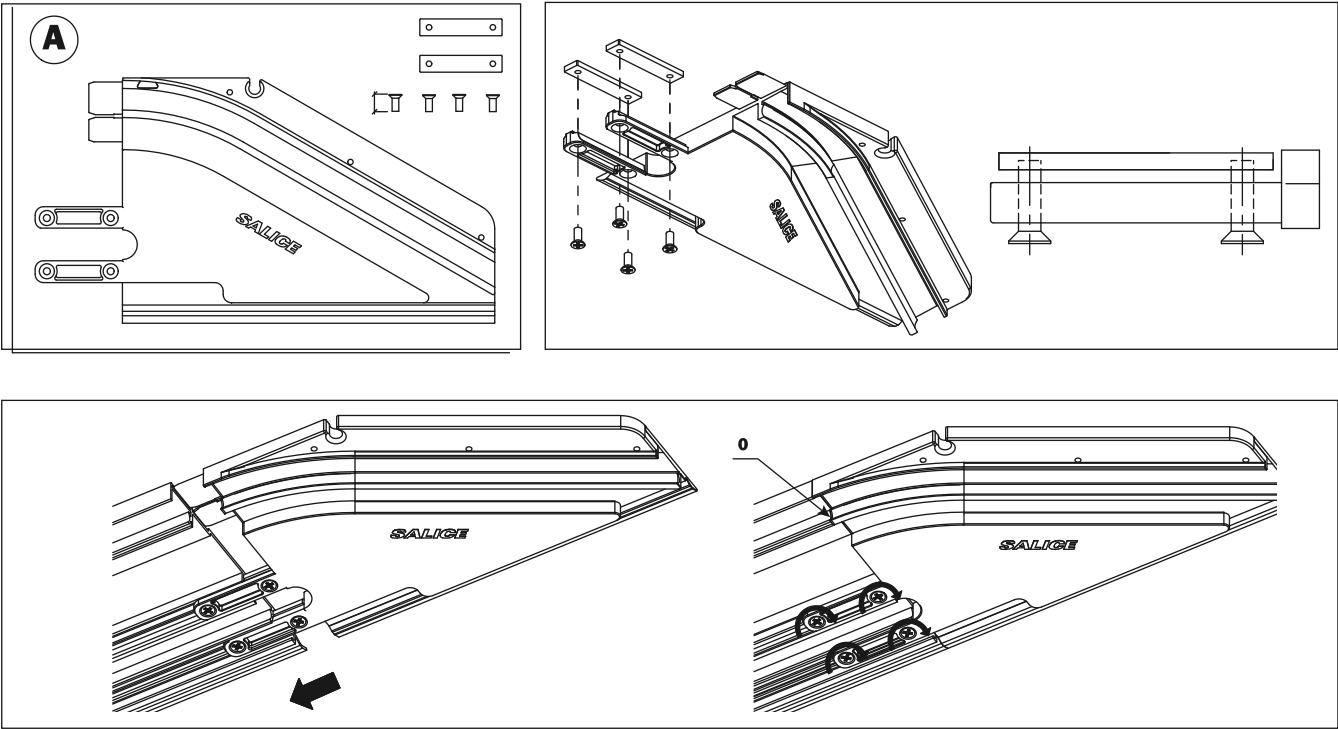

Adjusting the door opening angle



To adjust the opening angle, mount the component E supplied on the outer terminal. Insert the pin underneath component E into one of the numbered slots on the outer terminal. Each number corresponds to an opening angle, see table. Once the pin is in place, secure it using the screws supplied.

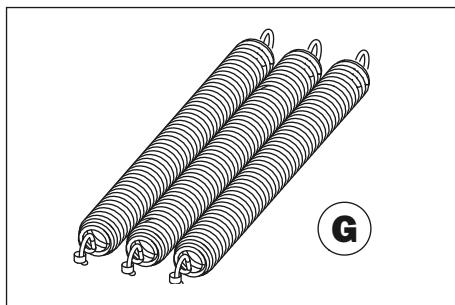

- if using Conecta hinges, fully insert the hinges as indicated by the arrows
- if using Series M hinges, engage the hinges on the mounting plates

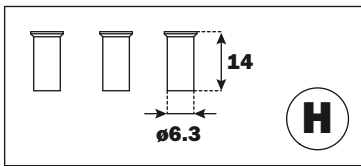


Once the hinges have been fully inserted, lock the hinges using the rear eccentric screw.



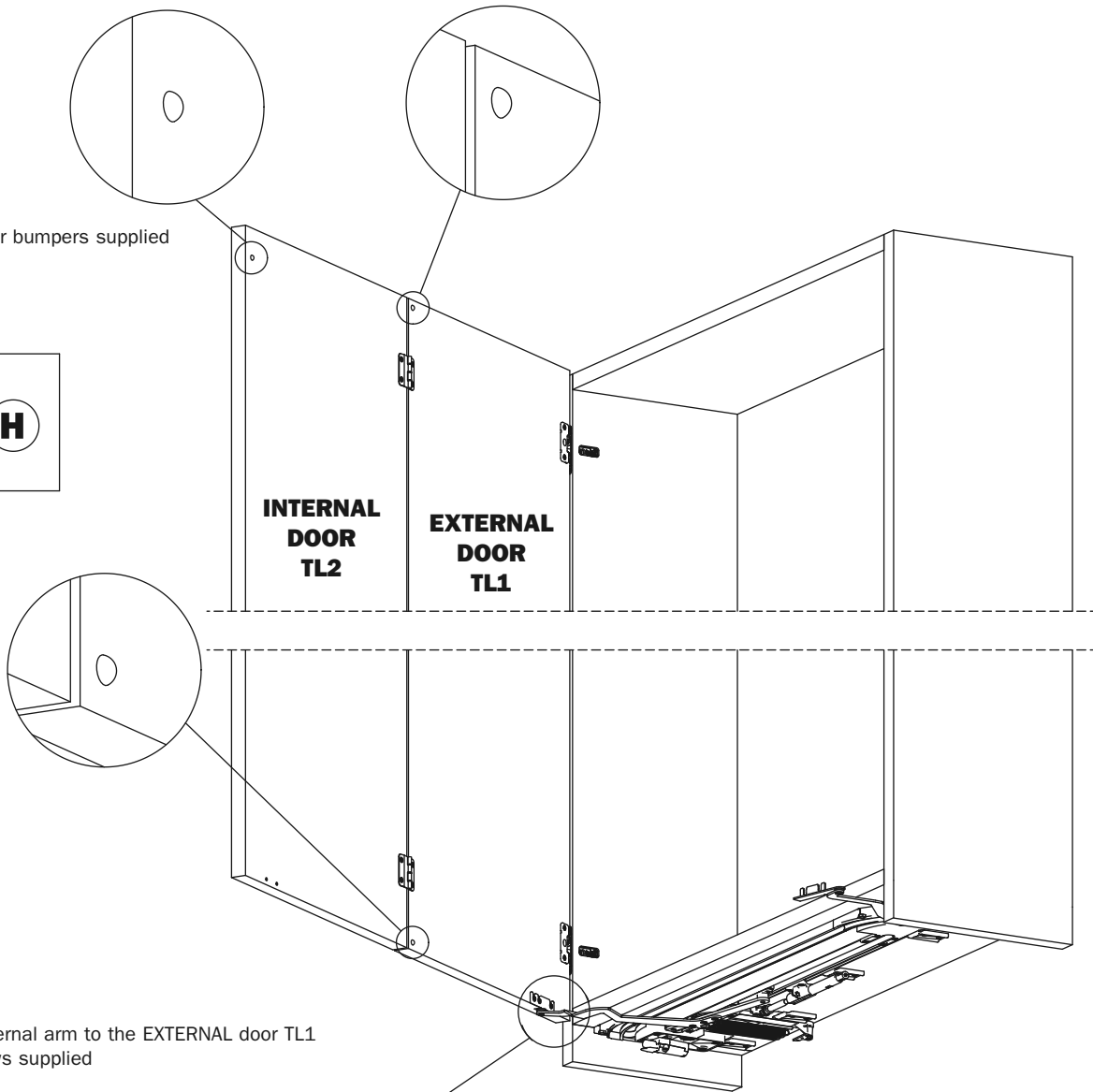
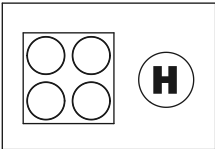

Compensating sideways adjustment from -3 to +3 mm.

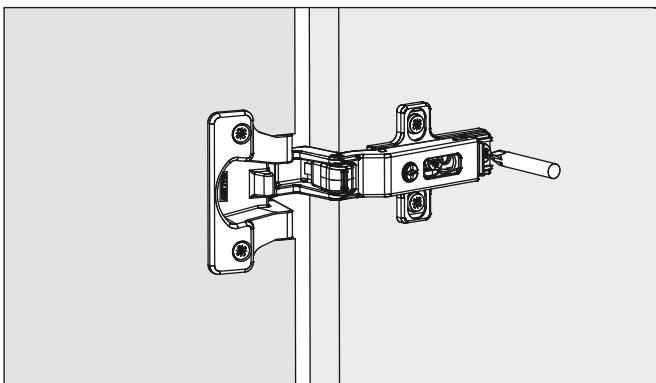
